What is decoding?

Decoding is the process of reading a word by sounding out the letter sounds and blending them together.

/m/ /a/ /p/ → "map"

Decodable books:

- Contain words using the letter sounds the pupil has learnt
- Provide essential **practice** of phonics skills
- Encourage children to **sound out** and decode each word
- Feature fewer than 20% high-frequency words



What are decodable books?

Designed for beginning reading, decodable books are carefully written stories and texts using only the letter sounds pupils have been taught. Decodable books provide pupils the opportunity to **practise** decoding skills with the phonics they have learnt.

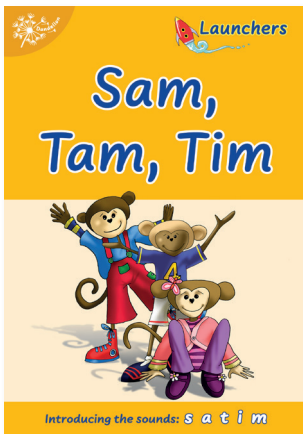

Why Phonic Books decodable books?

Phonic Books decodable books are created by reading specialists and have a history of engaging and delighting children learning to read.

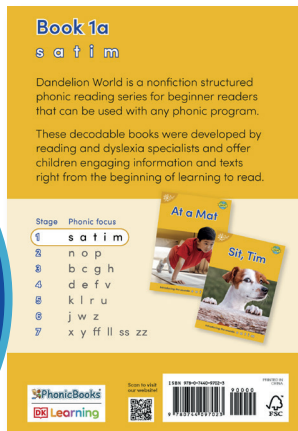
There are three series of Dandelion decodable books covering the sounds of the alphabet and double consonants. See tables on pages 6-9 for all titles and covers.



The phonic focus for the book is listed on the front cover.

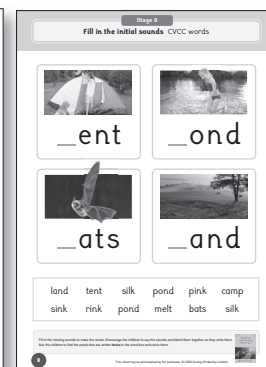
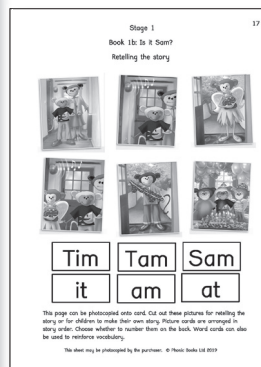
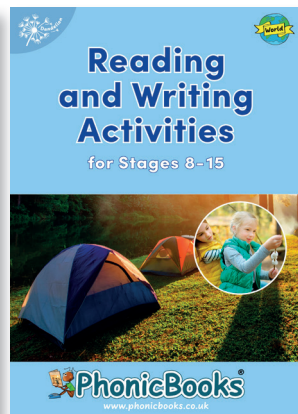
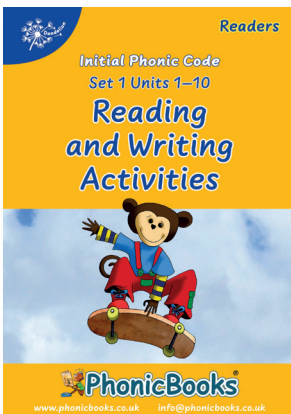
The phonic focus for the set is listed on the back cover to help match to your phonics teaching.

There is incremental and cumulative progression through the series. Two books (a and b) in Unit/Stage 1 cover the sounds s, a, t, i, and m. Two books (a and b) in Unit/Stage 2 cover the sounds n, o, p but also use the sounds s, a, t, i, m, and so on.



Phonic Books decodable readers provide reading practice and complement any structured literacy programme.

Each set has an accompanying book of photocopiable activities for you to use in the classroom or as reading interventions.



Activities correspond to the individual readers within the set.



Launchers

Dandelion Launchers is a fully decodable phonics series for beginner readers. Each unit introduces new letters/sounds while supporting previously taught phonic letters/sounds and high-frequency words. A game is included at the back of each book, offering a fun way to practise the new phonic skills and knowledge introduced in each unit.



Dandelion World is the parallel series to Dandelion Launchers, and covers a range of engaging non-fiction topics. Each book includes a non-fiction knowledge builder feature for children and adults to read together. This is a fun way to enhance vocabulary and deepen comprehension of the book's content.

Jazz Time!

Let's listen to some jazz! In a jazz band, you may hear **instruments** like the saxophone, trumpet, trombone, double bass, drums, and piano. The **musicians** sometimes make up **melodies** on the spot. People sing in jazz bands, too!



Do you hear just one instrument playing or one person singing? This is called a solo. Jazz musicians take turns having solos.

tradition: the way a certain group of people does something



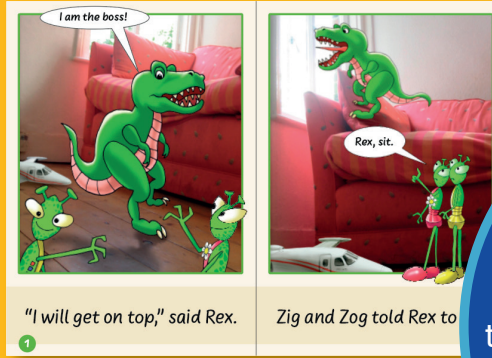
Trumpets and trombones belong to the same family, or group, of instruments—brass. Sometimes they are called horns.



Readers

Dandelion Readers is a series of books for beginner readers. The Readers Sets cover the initial phonic code, while the Readers Vowel Spellings introduce different spellings for vowel sounds. More text is included on each page to build reading stamina. A helpful Reading Practice section allows further practice of each new spelling taught.





Each series has accompanying **activity books**. These books are integral to the reading programme, as they include teaching and practice activities to **support the learner**.
